Poland – Slovakia – Hungary – Austria – Czech Republic

Day 1 Warsaw

On arrival to Warsaw you'll be met by our tou-escort and transfered to your hotel. Brief tour of Warsaw. Welcome dinner with folklore and polish food at local restaurant, overnight.

Day 2 Warsaw – Czestochowa – Cracow

After breakfast morning departure to Cracow, en route short visit to the Paulite Monastery built in 14th century (Religious centre of the religious cult of Poland, world's famous of miracle icon of Our Lady of Czestochowa known as Black Madonna). Dinner and overnight in Cracow.



Day 3 Cracow

Breakfast, half day city-tour – the historical Old Market Square with Sukiennice (renaissance market hall), Clock Hall and St. Mary's Church. Wavel Hill with old precious cathedral, the Jagiellonian University.

The balance of the day free for the optionals:

To Oswiecim – where Auschwitz is located. This was the largest of all German Nazi extermination camps, established in June 1940.

To Wieliczka. Famous 11th century Salt Mines with underground museum of salted figures. Dinner in the restaurant, overnight.

Day 4 Zakopane

Breakfast, morning departure to Zakopane - Polish capital of winter sports in Tatra Mountains. Enjoy the beauty of the region along the ride.

On the way visiting of the Congregation of Sister Faustina Kowalska. She worked and died here. After arrival in Zakopane, free time (optional) cable ride to Gubałówka Mt.

Dinner at regional tavern. Return to Cracow, overnight.

Day 5 Zakopane – Budapest

Breakfast followed by departure via motorcoach for Budapest. Brief stop in Banska Bystrica - pictureque Slovakian town. Dinner and overnight in Budapest.

Day 6 Budapest

After breakfast enjoy your morning sightseeing tour. The former cities of Buda and Pest are linked by a series of graceful bridges over the Danube River, The Royal Palace and the Coronation Church, Parliament Gellert Hill, Hero's square. Balance of the day free. Evening dinner at traditional restaurant with Gipsy Music.



Day 7 Budapest – Vienna

After morning breakfast departure to Vienna. The afternoon tour features the Hofburg once the seat of the Austro-Hungaria Empire, St. Stephan's Cathedral, Parliament etc.
Dinner and overnight in Vienna.

Day 8 Vienna

Morning tour in the magnificent Schöbrunn Palace. The rest of day free.
Evening dinner in the district of Vienna called Grinzing - unforgettable atmosphere in a typical Austrian inn.
Overnight.

Day 9 Vienna – Prague

Day 10 Prague
