

POLISH LANDSCAPES FROM NORTH TO SOUTH

Day 1 Warsaw

After arrival, meet the Top-Travel - guide.

In the evening welcome dinner at local restaurant. Overnight.

Day 2 Warsaw

Breakfast, half day city tour including Old Town, the Royal Route and Royal Garden-Lazienki, Fryderyk Chopin monument – well known Polish composer, Ghetto.

In the afternoon visit optionally in:

- ❖ Royal Castle in Warsaw (interior)
- ❖ Wilanów – the beautiful Baroque residence of King Jan III Sobieski
- ❖ Żelazowa Wola - Fryderyk Chopin's birthplace

Dinner, overnight.



Day 3 Malbork - Gdansk

Breakfast, drive to Gdansk via Malbork. A castle built in the 13th –15th centuries by the Knights of the Teutonic Order, one of the largest medieval fortresses in Europe.

Dinner and overnight in Gdansk.



Day 4 Gdansk - Gdynia - Sopot

Breakfast, all day city tour including:

Gdansk - Birthplace of Solidarity. Main Town Hall, Neptune Fountain, Golden Gate, Artus Court. Organ concert in Oliwa Cathedral.

Gdynia – Kościuszko Square with a yacht basin and well known sailing-ship (now museum) “Dar Pomorza”.

Sopot – popular seaside resort with the longest pier that extends into the Baltic Sea.

Free time for shopping.

In the evening dinner with folklore show at Kaszubian region . Overnight.

Day 5 Poznan

After breakfast drive to Poznan.- the largest city in west, one of the first capitals of Poland.

Late afternoon - accommodation in the hotel.

Free time. Visiting the Old Town.

Dinner and overnight.

Day 6 Poznan

Breakfast, half day city tour including Ostrow Tumski (Cathedral Island) with Gothic cathedral, Old Town with Market Square whose houses display fancy workmanship, fine renaissance - style Town Hall.

Free time.

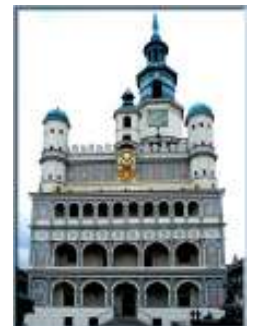
Optionally we propose:

- ❖ Castle in Kornik. This is one of the most attractive localities in Poland.

The castle built in 1426 in English Gothic style.

- ❖ Visit in Classical palace in Czarniejewo – built in 1780 is located in a vast park. Enjoy a buggy ride through a forest.

Dinner, overnight.



Day 7 Czestochowa - Cracow

After breakfast drive to Cracow, on the way stop in Czestochowa. Visit to the Paulite Monastery of Jasna Gora – one of the best known places in the world, famous religious center with the miracle Icon of Our Lady of Czestochowa (known as Black Madonna).

In the afternoon arrive to Cracow, dinner and overnight.



Day 8 Cracow

Breakfast, morning city-tour of Cracow including Wavel Hill with old precious gothic cathedral, the Old Market Square, St.Mary's Church. The Jagiellonian University – original buildings (15th century) of the oldest university in this part Europe.

Free time for shopping.

Optional in the afternoon we propose excursion to Oswiecim – where Auschwitz is located.

This was the largest of all German Nazi extermination camps, established in June 1940.

Dinner and overnight.

Day 9 Zakopane

Breakfast, drive to Zakopane – popular winter sports resort in the Tatra Mountains. Enjoy the beauty of the region along the ride.

On the way stop in Wadowice – birthplace of pope John Paul II where many mementos of his early life and his family can be found.

Arrive in Zakopane, free time.

Optionally we propose cable ride to Mount Gubalowka – where we can enjoy the most beautiful panoramic view of the Tatra Mountains.

Dinner with folklore entertainment at local tavern.

Return to Cracow, overnight.



Day 10 Cracow

Breakfast, excursion to Wieliczka. Famous 11th century Salt Mines (considered as the world's oldest still working factory) with underground museum of salted figures.

In the afternoon free time for last shopping in Cracow

Dinner, overnight.

Day 11 Warsaw

After breakfast drive back to Warsaw.

In the afternoon arrive to Warsaw. Farewell dinner at local restaurant.
